Neighbourhood Plan: The draft NHP plan (approved by the Councilors on 27th January 2017) has been submitted to Babergh D.C. for PUBLIC CONSULTATION which will run from 13 February 2017 to 31 March 2017. Then the Plan will be assessed by an INDEPENDENT EXAMINER. Full details are on our website www.lawshall.suffolk.gov.uk

Summer Fair & Fete: We have received some offers of help for this venture. It is hoped to arrange a meeting regarding this event in the near future.

Proposal received from Waldontelecom: proposed base station on East side of Donkey Lane, Lawshall. The proposed installation is required to facilitate 2G, 3G and 4G mobile coverage. This proposal was discussed at the P.C. meeting on the 14th February 2017 and the Councillors decided to support this proposal. The Clerk has contacted Waldontelecom to request details of radius and coverage for the village.

The Glebe Mini Market: Letter received from Babergh D.C. stating that they received notice on 8th February 2017 from Jones Lang La-Salle Ltd on behalf of the owner of the Glebe Mini Market stating that they intend to dispose of the property. As the shop is registered as an Asset of Community Value the P.C. has submitted an Expression of Interest which will delay the disposal of the property until 8th August 2017.

Dog fouling: It has been reported that this is still occurring in several places in the village. We would remind all dog owners that it is a punishable offence to **not** clear up after your dog.

Bird Notes March 2017 by Cliff Cooper

Our starlings must have taken umbrage at the comments I made about them last month as the majority of them have left us! We did have up to forty staying with us, but this number has fallen to no more than ten. I suspect the truth of the matter is that the rest were birds that had come here for the winter from further north or east, and that they have decided the worst of the winter is over so they have made the journey back home for their breeding season. We will just have to wait until next winter to see whether they return here.

On the subject of starlings, did you know that you can tell the males from the females in spring? No it's not the females that make all the noise (sorry girls!)- the males have a bluey patch at the base of the lower mandible (beak). I didn't know that until very recently, did you?

Another slightly strange occurrence recently caught my eye; there was a fairly large flock of fieldfares and redwings in the Golden Wood area, about 500 birds in total. I noticed that the majority, probably more than two thirds, were redwings. I would normally expect the fieldfares to be in much the greater number. To reinforce this anomaly, a friend informed me that he had seen a smaller flock of around a hundred birds near Nowton Park and they were all redwings! I have no idea about any possible explanation for this apparent change in the proportions of the birds in these flocks - are redwing numbers increasing, are fieldfare numbers decreasing, or is it simply a coincidence? Again, we will have to wait and see.

Now that the weather has warmed up a little the birds have started singing, especially welcome is the beautiful skylark trill.

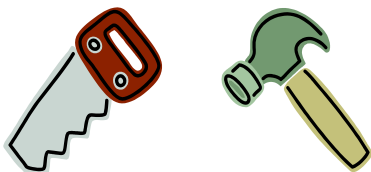

The month started with average temperatures throughout the first week , ending with the highest temperature on the **8th** at 10.4 °C during the day. The second week was a little colder with some snow flurries on the **13th** that did not lead to any settled snow on the ground. In the third week the temperatures dropped away giving an average night -time figure of -0.9 °C with the lowest recorded at -2.3 °C on the **21st**. The remainder of the month saw seasonally average temperatures and low rainfall. It is worth noting that although only 51mm of rain fell during the month 18 of those fell in the last two days.
